This position will perform duties as a part of the ISU advanced machinery innovations lab which currently employs 22 staff and graduate students. The Program Manager will also be responsible for providing program leadership in areas of project planning; team communication, personnel management, budget projections and management; task prioritization; and program outcome management. The Program Manager will be the primary lead for research project schedule coordination and alignment of research outcomes with external sponsors, and significant interactions with industrial project sponsors is anticipated. Other duties include meeting regularly with research team members; providing workflow management support; mentoring young professionals; and having daily interactions with online team project management tools. Upon absence of the Research Team Director, this position will serve as the primary program lead. The successful candidate will possess effective time management skills; excellent communication and organizational skills; and be detail oriented. The candidate will also be

The candidate will also be a motivated self-starter and possess the ability to thoroughly conduct and document project management processes. Additionally, the candidate will have problem solving skills and the ability to manage program change. All staff members are expected to interact collegially

and maintain the highest standards of integrity and ethics.

This position will travel approximately 15% of the time. This includes both domestic and some international travel.

Bachelor's degree and five years related experience OR Master's degree and three years related experience OR Ph.D. or other doctoral/professional program and some related experience. Related education and experience must be in a relevant field to include Engineering, Business Management, Project Management, or related field.

Experience with management and oversight of the personnel resources and budgets including open ended problem solving of budget issues.
